

# The Clare Riesling

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Left on lees and stirred periodically over four-months following a cool fermentation, this is Clare to a T. A bit softer and textural than most, its chief virtue. Spa salts, lemon oil and citrus zest, careening along talcy acid rails, bright and juicy. This is light to mid-weighted, punchy and yet far from shrill or hard. A nice drink.
