From where vines meet the sea in McLaren Vale, to the fertile red soils of Clare Valley and beyond, we work directly with family-owned vineyards and growers to produce our award-winning wines. Many have been part of the RockBare journey since we took our first steps 20 years ago. Our first wine - a Shiraz from a vineyard near Port Willunga where rugged rocks flank the shore - was the inspiration behind our name. We select grapes from the best regions across the diverse state of South Australia; long regarded as one of Australia's best grape growing regions

REGIONALITY

McLaren Vale, South Australia

McLaren Vale is the birthplace of wine in South Australia. Its Mediterranean climate and proximity to the ocean means this region receives a cooling effect from winds. Cabernet Sauvignon shines from cooler sites which are ideal for producing full-bodied, classically expressive Cabernets such as this.

TASTING NOTE

Bold ruby red in colour. The nose is ultra-appealing with blueberry, black current and hints of tobacco leaves and capsicum. The palate is rich featuring black current, savoury and chalky tannin. The finish is gently spiced with a delectable cigar box toastiness.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol – 14.5% pH – 3.64 Acid – 5g/L Sugar – Dry
