Our first wine - a Shiraz from a vineyard near Port Willunga where rugged rocks flank the shore - was the inspiration behind our name. We select grapes from the best regions across the diverse state of South Australia; long regarded as one of Australia's best grape growing regions

REGIONALITY

Limestone Coast, South Australia

The Limestone Coast is a geographically diverse region located in the southeastern part of South Australia, known for its natural beauty, limestone formations and fertile farmland. The fertile soil and favourable climate of the region are core to producing Chardonnay that showcases crisp acidity, fruitiness, and refreshing restraint.

TASTING NOTE

Pale yellow colour with lovely vibrancy! Rich notes of ripe apple, lavender, creamy butter and a hint of green bean on the nose. The palate is broad and generous with yellow apple and banana. A slight toastiness complements the finish.
