

## CLICK '99 PINOT GRIS 2025

From where vines meet the sea in McLaren Vale, to the fertile red soils of Clare Valley and beyond, we work directly with family-owned vineyards and growers to produce our award-winning wines. Many have been part of the RockBare journey since we took our first steps 20 years ago. Our first wine - a Shiraz from a vineyard near Port Willunga where rugged rocks flank the shore - was the inspiration behind our name. We select grapes from the best regions across the diverse state of South Australia; long regarded as one of Australia's best grape growing regions

These wines are named after the year of our first vintage and Peter Click, the founding partner and friend of RockBare. Click '99.

R E G I O N A L I T Y Currency Creek, South Australia

Sourced from select vineyards in Currency Creek which sits on South Australia's Fleurieu Peninsula. The subregion, named after the Creek with the same name that empties into Lake Alexandria features incredibly fertile alluvial and limestone rich soils, core to adding a distinct minerality to our Pinot Gris. This area produces Pinot Gris with vibrant acidity, delicate floral aromas, and a beautifully textured palate.

## TASTING NOTE

Pale straw in colour with flash of underlying blush. A classic Pinot Gris with notes of fresh lychee, white florals, kenz apple and pineapple. The palate is deliciously generous with lush crispy apple and pear.
