From where vines meet the sea in McLaren Vale, to the fertile red soils of Clare Valley and beyond, we work directly with family-owned vineyards and growers to produce our award-winning wines. Many have been part of the RockBare journey since we took our first steps 20 years ago. Our first wine - a Shiraz from a vineyard near Port Willunga where rugged rocks flank the shore - was the inspiration behind our name. We select grapes from the best regions across the diverse state of South Australia; long regarded as one of Australia's best grape growing regions

REGIONALITY

Clare Valley, South Austalia

While the Clare Valley may be wildly renowned for it's Riesling production, Shiraz is the hidden gem we should all be drinking more of. The combination of a Mediterranean climate (long warm days and short cool nights), sitting about 420m above sea level and terra rossa soils is key to our approachable and fruit forward Shiraz.

## TASTING NOTE

Dark purple in colour, this inky Shiraz is iconically Clare. Bright dark plum fruits, black cherry and rosewater on the nose. The palate is luscious and vibrant, minty and silky. Milk chocolate and a fine dusting of tanning compliment the finish.
