REGIONALITY

Langhorne Creek, South Australia

Langhorne Creek wines, particularly known for their rich and fruit-driven Shiraz, offer a distinctive character marked by deep, ripe red fruit characters, earthy tannins, and a smooth, approachable style, thanks to the region's cool maritime influence and fertile alluvial soils.

TASTING NOTE

Dark purple in colour, this inky Shiraz is iconically South Australian. Bright dark plum fruits, black cherry and rosewater on the nose. The palate is luscious and vibrant, minty and silky. Milk chocolate and a fine dusting of tanning compliment the finish.

Alcohol – 14.5% pH – 3.58

Acid – 6.17g/L Sugar – Dry
