This estate's represents a joint venture between the Jackson and Valmorbida families. Certainly, the economic muscle of the former provides a platform for abstemious yields, the selection of optimal fruit and winemaking that is as traditional or experimental as it needs to be to allow these virtues to come to the fore. A thirst-slaking rose that does not subterfuge grenache's tendency toward ripeness in the name of acid retention. Thankfully, because it is saline and fresh enough.
